Grey Box One Site

This is a simple way to display a external page from your site by simply clicking on a text link and it will open in a lightbox style fashion you can add what ever site you wish to be displayed

Description of the Properties

General

GreyBox OneSite Window Url

Insert the website address that you wish to open with greybox.

GreyBox OneSite Page Title

Displays the site name of the site that you want to visit. Example Google

Specify a page name to open in with page size. (See Default For Example)

Displays the name of the site that you want to visit. Example Visit Google

GreyBox OneSite Browser Width

Specify the width of page to be used for display in greybox.onsite.

Note for best results keep the width of the page to 800 maximum I have noticed that if you make it anymore than this the page wont center and gets pulled to the left of display/monitor, but feel free to test and width that you wish to use.

GreyBox OneSite Browser Height

Specify the height of page to be used for display in greybox.onsite

Note for best results keep the height of the page to 550 maximum I have noticed that if you make it anymore than this the page displayed drops below the setting of the page Example 1024x768. But feel free to test any height in the extension that you wish to

Settings

Font Weight

Set the weight of the font from normal to bolder and from 100 to 900.

Font Family

Set the font to be used for link text example of font that can be used Ariel.

Font Size

Set the font size to be used for link text. Example 12

Font Color

Set the font color to be displayed for link text Example Red =#CC0000

Font Style

Set the style of font Example *Italic*

Font Variant

Set the variant Example small-caps.

Text Decoration

Set the decoration to show whether to have underline or none.

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

Copy all files from this zip file to the Web Builder folder. Usually this folder is called: C:\Program Files\WYSIWYG Web Builder 7

After restarting the application, the GreyBox One Site will be available in the Toolbox and main menu.
