Dockmenu Images

Insert the images to be used in the menu you can also add a url a alt tag description.

2. Dockmenu Font Settings

Dockmenu Font Weight

Set the font weight to be used for the text in the menu.

Dockmenu Font Size

Set the font size to be used for the text in the menu.

Dockmenu Font Name

Set the font size to be used for the text in the menu. You can only use websafe font for displaying text in the menu.

Dockmenu Font Color

Set the font color to be used for the text in the menu.

3. Dockmenu Image Settings

Dockmenu MaxWidth

Specify the width of the images used in the menu Max Width from images slide 40-150 max

Dockmenu Item Width

Specify the Item width (space between the images) 10-150 max

Dockmenu Proximity

Proximity from the images (How smooth it slides with mouseover) 10-100 max
