

## jQuery Shadow - Version 1.0

The jQuery Shadow extension is an easy way to add cool shadow effects to objects without using images. This extension is a wrapper for the jQuery Shadow plugin by Syd Lawrence: <https://github.com/sydlawrence/jquery-shadow>

Note: the effect will be visible when you preview or publish the page.

### ***Properties***

#### **Selector**

Specifies a filter for the items. This can be any valid jQuery selector (<http://api.jquery.com/category/selectors/>).

Default value: **#wb\_Image1**. This is the ID of **Image1**

Note: For some objects you do not need the 'wb\_' prefix.

To add the shadow to all images on the page you can use: **img**

#### **Type**

The plugin supports several different shadow types: 'standard', 'lifted', 'perspective', 'raised' and 'sides'.

#### **Sides**

When the shadow type is set to 'sides' you can use this option to specify the shadow sides.

***How to install this extension so it is available in Quick `n Easy Web Builder?***

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:  
/Documents/Quick `n Easy Web Builder/extensions/
