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Why a totally new product?

One of the most frequently asked questions we get is 'Is there also a Mac version of this software?' Unfortunately WYSIWYG Web Builder cannot run on the Mac and its source code cannot be ported to the Mac because it uses many Windows technologies that work very differently on the Mac. So we decided to create a complete new product designed from scratch specially designed for the Mac, but with the possibility to port it to Windows and Linux.

Although we've integrated the best features of WYSIWYG Web Builder into Quick 'n Easy Web Builder, it is not the same software! It does not use the same project structure and projects are not interchangeable.

The core of the software is very different because Quick 'n Easy Web Builder has to be compatible with multiple operating systems, also many of the used technologies in WYSIWYG Web Builder are not available on other platforms (yet). However Quick 'n Easy Web Builder is still very advanced and it certainly will be one of the best web design tools available for the Mac/Linux!

When will it be available?

We are currently doing some last minute testing and fine tuning. We plan to release a public beta within a few weeks. Hopefully we can release a stable version not long after that...

Does this mean there will no new releases of WYSIWYG Web Builder?

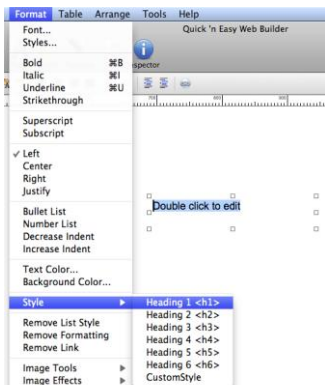
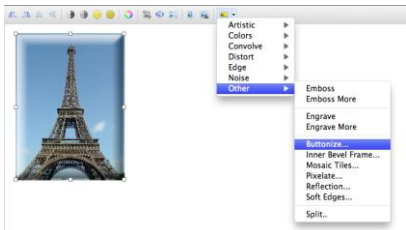
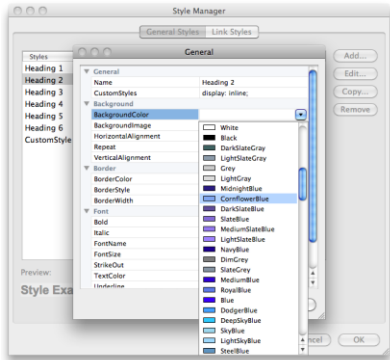
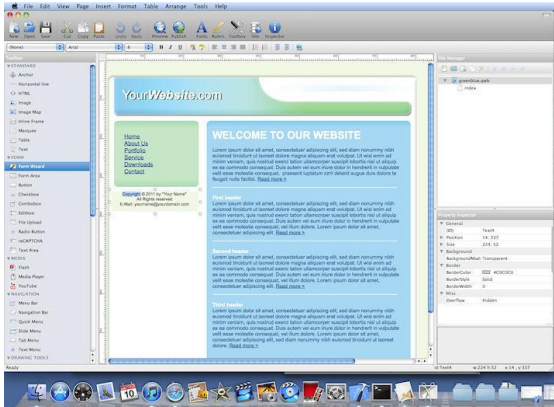

What are the differences between WYSIWYG Web Builder and Quick' n Easy Web Builder?

Quick 'n Easy Web Builder was build from the ground up using technologies available on as many platforms as possible. For this reason the application looks and feels quite different than WYSIWYG Web Builder. It uses different toolbars, different menus, a different text editor etc...
