

PHP Password Protect Extension - Version 1.0

This extension provides an easy way to password protect a web page. Simply drag & drop this object on your page, set the password and your page is password protected!

This extension uses PHP, so the file extension of the page must be set to "PHP"!

Description of the properties

ButtonText

Specifies the text to be shown for the login button.

Font

Specifies the font used for text within the login form.

PasswordLabelText

Specifies the text that identifies the password text box on the login form.

TextColor

Specifies text color of the login form.

TitleText

Specifies the text shown for the title.

Font name

Specifies the font type (facename).

Font size

Specifies the size of the font.

Text color

Specifies the color of the text

IntroMessage

Specifies the text to be shown on the protected page. Typically this message will let the user know that this page is password protected.

Or you can also display a message where the user can request the password.

Password

Specifies the password of the page.

Note:

If you use the same password for multiple pages then the user does not have to login again for the other page(s) with that same password.

PasswordInvalidErrorText

Specifies the text to be shown when the password is invalid.

How to install this extension so it is available in Quick 'n Easy Web Builder?

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:

/Documents/Quick 'n Easy Web Builder/extensions/

- Quick 'n Easy Web Builder 1.0 or later
