1. Greybox Browser Settings

Insert the url to be directed to onclick of the image.

Greybox Page Title

Specify the title to be used.

Greybox Image

Insert the image to be used for onclick to redirect to a browser window.

Greybox Image ID

Specify a unique id for each image used on page. (Image1, Image2, Image3)

Greybox Image Alt

Add a alt name to be used for the image.

Greybox Z-Order

Specify a z-order of the image this is only need if you find the the image gets placed behind another object, shape or other images on the same page.

2. Greybox BrowserBorder Settings

Grey Box Image Border Color

Select the color of the border to be used for image.

Grey Box Image Border Size

Specify the size of the border to surround the image

Grey Box Image Border Style

Select the border style to be used for surrouding the image

Grey Box Image Height

Set the height of the image to be used on page.

Grey Box Image Width

Set the width of the image to be used on page.

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

Copy all files from this zip file to the Web Builder folder. Usually this folder is called:

C:\Program Files\WYSIWYG Web Builder 7

After restarting the application, the **Grey Box Browser Image Extension** will be available in the Toolbox and main menu.
