## Grey Box Gallery Browser Extension

This is a simple way to display a external page from your site by simply clicking on a text link and it will open in a lightbox style fashion you can add what ever site you wish to be displayed

### *Description of the Properties*

#### 1. Grey Box Browser

##### **Browser Window**

Insert the website address that you wish to open with greybox.

##### **Page Title**

Displays the site name of the site that you want to visit. Example Google

##### **Page Link**

Displays the name of the site that you want to visit. Example Visit Google

##### **Font Family**

Change the Font type to suit what font you are already using or use another form the list

##### **Font Color**

Choose what color of font you wish to use this may be the same as the color you are already using on page

##### **Font Size**

Choose a font size to display the text you use in the heading

#### 2. Greybox Browser Settings

##### **Font Weight**

Set the weight of the font from normal to bolder and from 100 to 900.

##### **Font Family**

Set the font to be used for link text example of font that can be used Ariel.

##### **Font Size**

Set the font size to be used for link text. Example 12

##### **Font Color**

Set the font color to be displayed for link text Example Red =#CC0000

##### **Font Style**

Set the style of font Example *Italic*

##### **Font Variant**

Set the variant Example small-caps.

##### **Text Decoration**

Set the decoration to show whether to have underline or none.

**Note** To use this extension simply drag onto design area open the extension properties set to what you wish and close properties if you wish to add a second link copy and paste the extension already in your design area again open the extension properties set to what you wish to be displayed and close. I had to build this way as it was the only way to get it to work as it should. I tried another way but it only showed one link on page after you opened in browser window. If I can fix this it will be fixed.

Note this extension no longer needs the use of XHTML 1.0 Transitional so all users of WB5/6 no longer have to set or make alterations to html to make extension work.
