

Vertical Dock Menu

Transform a set of images into a Mac-like Dock vertical menu, with icons that expand on roll-over! The disadvantage to this version of the dock-menu is that it's not quite as smooth as the Fisheye plugin dock, although it's still very fluid and certainly usable.

1. Stack Dock Menu Images

Stack Dock Images

Insert the images that you wish to use for the menu plus enter the image name and the url to be used.

2. Stack Dock Menu Settings

Stack Dock Step

The timer interval (in milliseconds) between each animation step of the 'on-Dock' expansion, and the 'off-Dock' shrinkage. Default = 50

Stack Dock Labels

This enables/disables display of a label on the current image. 'tc','tl', 'tc', 'tr', 'ml', 'mc', 'mr', 'bl', 'bc', 'br'.

Further information

Allowed string values are 2 characters in length: the first character indicates horizontal position (t=top, m=middle, b=bottom) and the second indicates vertical position (l=left, c=center, r=right). So 'br' means bottom-right!

If simply set to true, jqDock will use its default positioning for the label, which is 'tl' (top-left) for any align setting other than 'top' or 'left'. The defaults for 'top' and 'left' alignment are 'br' (bottom-right) and 'tr' (top-right) respectively.

To determine the text for the label, jqDock looks firstly for text in the image's 'title' attribute; if not found, it will then look for text in the 'title' attribute of the parent link - if there is one - and use that if found.

Stack Dock Duration

The duration (in milliseconds) of the initial 'on-Dock' expansion, and the 'off-Dock' shrinkage. Default = 200

Stack Dock Alignment

Fixes the vertical main axis, and direction of expansion. String, default = 'right', values = 'left', 'center', 'right'.

Further information

For a vertical menu:

- 'left' : fixes the **left** edge of the dock, so that images expand **right**
- 'center' : fixes the **center** of the images, so that images expand **left** and **right** equally
- 'right' : fixes the **right** edge of the dock, so that images expand **left**

Stack Dock Icon Size

This is the maximum value (in pixels) of the minor axis dimension for the 'at rest' images default = 48

Stack Dock Icon Distance

Attenuation distance from cursor, ie the distance (in pixels) from the cursor that an image has to be within in order to have any expansion applied.

3. Stack Dock Menu Styles

Stack Dock Font

Select a color to be used for the text in the menu.

Stack Dock Text Color

Select the color to be used for the text.

Stack Dock Font Size

Select the size of font to be used for the text in the menu.

Stack Dock Font Style

Select a font style to be used for the text in the menu.

Stack Dock Font Weight

Select the font weight to be used for the text in the menu.

Stack Dock Background Color

Select a color to be used for the background of the text in the menu.

4. Stack Dock Menu jQuery

When using with other extensions that use jQuery you can select to turn off the jQuery script within this extension to avoid conflicts. To use = jquery.min.js To turn off= <!-- Use separate jQuery-->

Built with Extension Builder 2.5.2 (WB 7.X.X)

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

Copy all files from this zip file to the Web Builder folder.

After restarting the application, the Vertical Dock Menu will be available in the Toolbox and main menu.
